




## Introducing LifeRing 6.01

We have just released the latest version of our LifeRing software for both Military and First Responder markets. There are a myriad of new features and capabilities which we will outline in detail in the next few newsletters. Earlier this year, we upgraded our system to accommodate 10,000+ users. This upgrade adds support for PTT for this increase in users as well as the ability to display 10,000-20,000 of real-time tracks and sensors reports for our Web and Thick clients for PC, Android and iOS devices. We have added a radar interface for Echodyne radars. And we recently partnered with XQ to enable Zero Trust NIST 800-171 advanced encryption for all data, PTT and video exchanges within LifeRing.



## PC Client Enhancements:

- New Augmented Symbols displaying real-time Air and Ship traffic
- Ability to click on real time Air and Sea sensor track symbols to obtain expanded Info and Images
- Ability to add a Time to Start on Markers and Military Tactical Graphics
- Weather Overlay on Maps
- Elevation Line of Sight
- Elevation Profile to determine Radar height/range
- Ability to Engage a User Symbol with a Hostile Track of Marker and generate the appropriate Link-16 messages
- Ability to Pair User Symbols and Marker Symbols to Tracks
- Low RF Targeting visibility controls

## Android Enhancements:

Ability to view Military Tactical Graphics

Web Client Updates:

- Ability to view live video streams from Android handsets, PC web cams and IP cameras
- New Augmented Symbols displaying real-time Air and Ship traffic
- Ability to add a Time to Start on Markers and Tactical Graphics
- Ability to Filter Symbols displayed on the map
- Weather Overlay on Maps
- Ability to draw Tactical Graphics
