
AGIS LifeRing Playback Function Enables After-Action Review

It is common to wish to review an operation or exercise. While an after-action report is useful, it cannot convey the same sense as watching the actions being carried out on the screen in front of you. In order to review these actions, LifeRing features a Playback tool that can be used to review the experience of a selected LifeRing PC Client during a session. All of the LifeRing Server communications that a PC client received during a session are stored in recording files on that PC client's workstation. Playback will display all actions taken during the session, as well as all messages, markers, chats, whiteboards and tactical graphics that were received from the LifeRing Server. This review can be done in real time or in fast-forward, which is accomplished by skipping past all moments when there is not an action taking place.



It is a simple tool, reminiscent of any media player. The controls are Play, Fast Forward, Pause, Loop, Stop and Restart. Because the recording plays back the session exactly as the LifeRing client received communication from the server, it is not possible to rewind. The Loop setting can be used to automatically restart the session when it completes.
