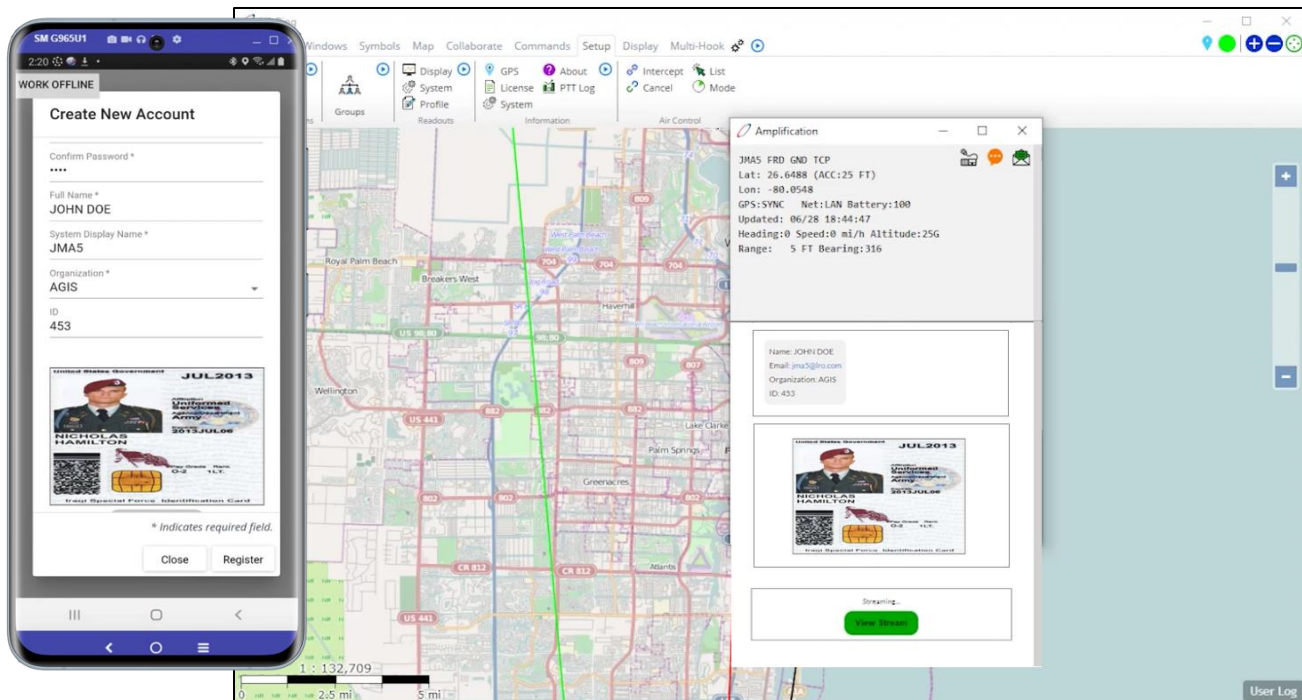


LifeRing's Profile Feature Ensures You Know Who's Who in the System

There is a significant issue associated with Common Operational Picture (COP) Smartphones and PCs being captured and then used by hostile forces. AGIS-enabled devices eliminate this issue through several built-in features.

All users have an active Profile attached to their user symbol. This includes their Full Name, Profile Photo, Email, Display Name, Organization, ID Number, ID Photo, Position and Phone Number. Any user in the system can click on another user to view this information and verify their identity. If you suspect that an enemy is posing as the owner of any device, each LifeRing-enabled device can use the device's own camera inside the app to live-stream a selfie video. This can be compared - in real-time - to the Profile photo to verify their identity.



User Profiles and Streaming Video are just a few of the many Security checks built into AGIS's C5IRS system to assure that our forces are not deceived and to protect your users, data and mission plans.
