

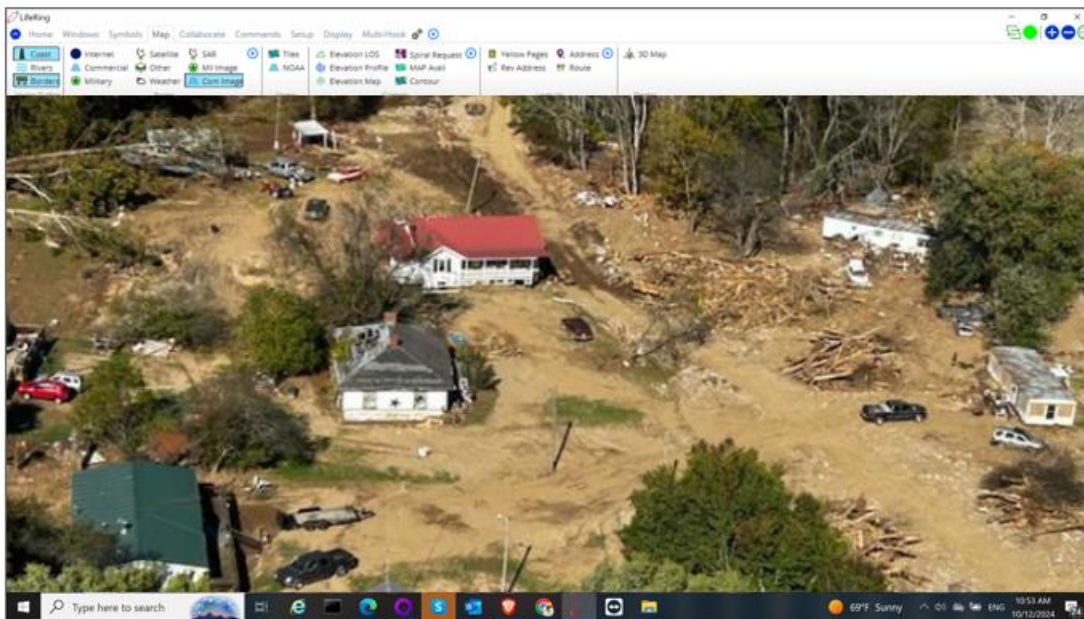
AGIS, Cloud WAN, VST and Maxar Aide in North Carolina Rescue Efforts

A consortium of hardware and software technology companies are currently assisting rescue efforts in North Carolina by providing satellite imagery, cellular, satellite and radio communications and drones with video capabilities and situational awareness software. This is being done without pay or reimbursement.

After Hurricane Helene wreaked havoc through North Carolina, the rescue efforts began almost immediately. There was no power, phone lines or commercial internet. Coordinating routes to get responders in and people out was especially challenging.

Brian Clark, CEO of Cloud WAN Solutions, LLC, stepped in and is providing an always available network of cellular, StarLink satellite and radio communications that automatically falls over to the best available communications enabling those on the ground and in helicopters to have coordinated communications. Aaron Schradin, CEO of Virtual Sandtable LLC, is providing real-time high-resolution video feeds of the area to assist the responders.

Responding volunteers are using the AGIS CJADC2 software to provide common situational awareness of the those in need (water, food, etc.) and the location of other responders on the ground and in the air. All can view videos from the helicopters and Maxar satellite data with the precise location of all users on their AGIS software enhanced PCs, handsets and tablets. The app also supports in-app push-to-talk, chat, messaging, video feeds and other tools and was developed in collaboration with the US JCS J6 Lab in Suffolk, VA.



Maxar satellite imagery provided by the US Government is overlaid on maps to enable knowledge of the situation. The Responders can drop markers at specific locations on the computer displayed maps of people in need and roads and bridges that are impassable. Below is a helicopter screen shot of one of the areas.
