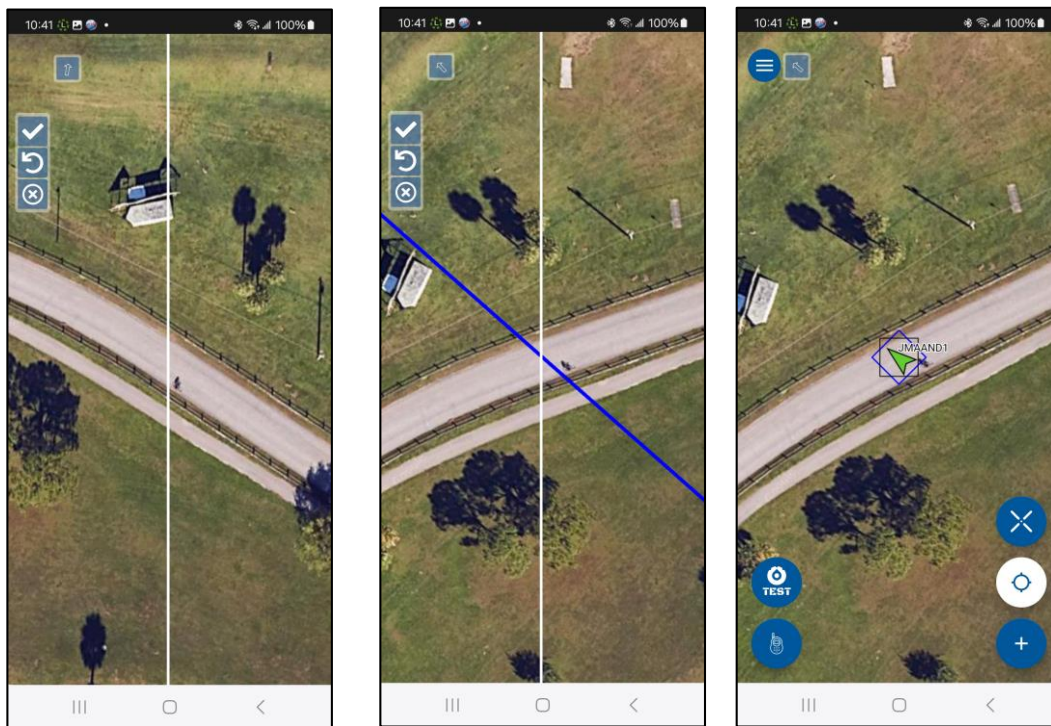


LifeRing Features New Assisted GPS Tool

GPS locations services are a valuable tool in Command and Control systems and vital to situational awareness to your surroundings as well as to other soldiers or responders. In many military and large emergency response scenarios, we can't assume that there will be reliable communication to show us our location.

LifeRing now features an Assisted GPS tool. Assisted GPS helps you triangulate your position when your device does not have access to GPS data or Location Services. A guideline overlaid on your device screen allows you to line up an object in your field of vision along with your general location to that object. Once that line is established it remains on the screen and a new line allows you to line up a second object in your field of vision along with your general location to that object. Once you set that line, it creates an intersection of the two lines that establishes your location on the map.
