AGIS' LifeRing Enables In-App Video Calling

LifeRing now allows operators to have encrypted, in-app, video calls with any other operator on the network with a camera enabled device.

An operator simply selects another user from the user list or locates their symbol on the map. A one-tap menu button initiates the call. Once the receiver accepts the call, it creates a secure, one-to-one, video call between the two operators.

Command can use a video call to to verify any operator's ID by making sure that their appearance corresponds to their profile photo. They can have them use their camera to show and discuss the tactical situation. In both cases the video and the associate audio is retained for playback.

In special forces missions or rapid response scenarios, video comms shorten the observe—orient—decide—act (OODA) loop.
