

AGIS Successfully Participates in UNITAS 2025

AGIS recently participated in UNITAS 2025 where we deployed our LifeRing system with PCs, Androids and Tablets that gave participants a Common Operational Picture of the operation on a mapped display with the precise location of all users.

UNITAS is a multinational maritime exercise that took place from September 15 to October 6, 2025, along the East Coast of the United States. The 66th iteration of the world's longest-running annual multinational maritime exercise, it focused on enhancing interoperability, readiness, and partnerships through a series of events at locations like Naval Station Mayport, Camp Lejeune, and Naval Station Norfolk. Approximately 8,000 personnel from 26 allied and partner nations participated in various training events on multiple ships, submarines, and aircraft. This included live-fire exercises, a SINKEX, and an amphibious ship-to-shore landing.



The LifeRing system was able to process multiple sources of sensor data to show the location of ships, aircraft and drones and exchange that data with other C5ISR Systems across various formats with our own Multi-Domain Datalink Translator.

The system also enabled the exchange of voice communications and well as real-time video both between users as well as from the UAV cameras.
