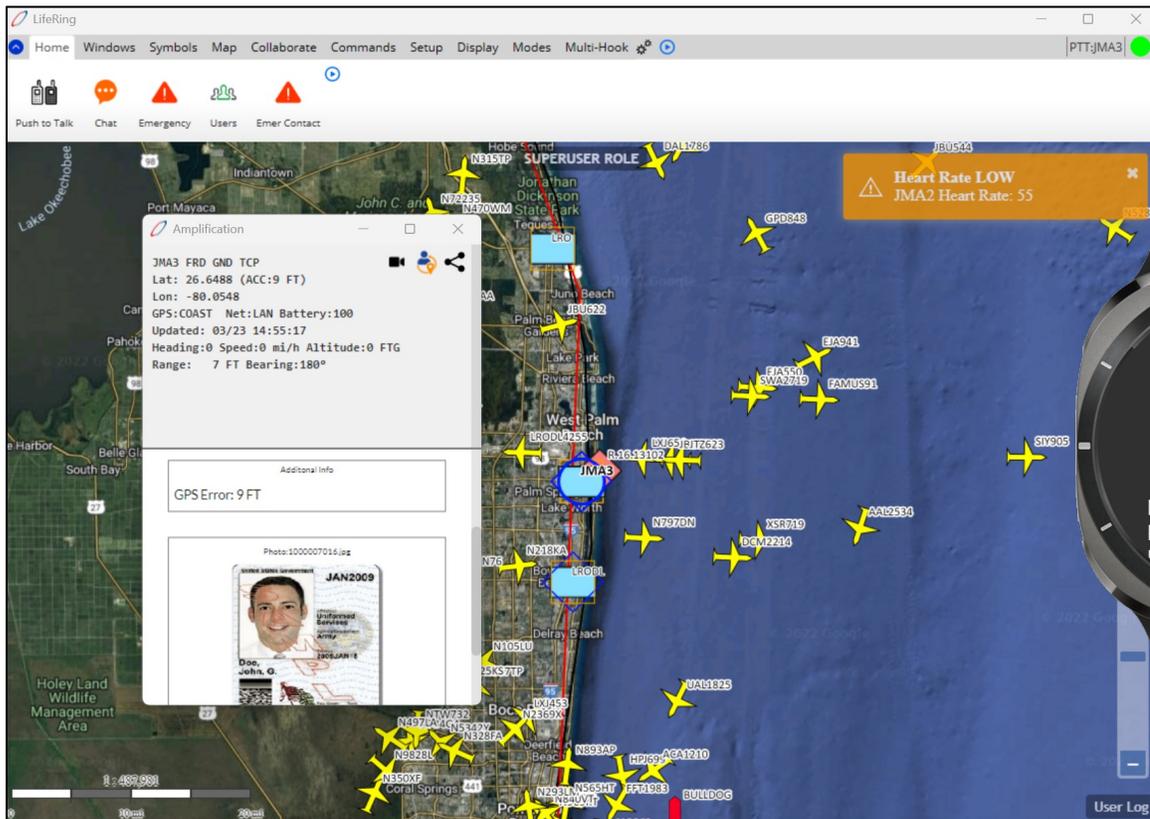


## LifeRing Adds Profile to the Tactical Smartwatch

In fast-moving operations, personnel from multiple units, agencies, or jurisdictions are often unknown to one another. The LifeRing Smartwatch System now in addition to the AGIS Smartphone System enables all users have an active Profile attached to their user symbol. This includes their Full Name, Profile Photo, Email, Display Name, Organization, ID Number, Position and military contact information. Any user in the system can click on another user to view this information and verify their identity...from the Command Center...down to the tactical Smartwatch.

The ability for every user in the LifeRing C2 system to maintain a verified profile adds a critical layer of identity assurance and operational trust in the Common Operational Picture (COP). This reduces reliance on voice-only identification (which can be misheard or spoofed). This feature transforms the COP from just a map of positions into a map of verified people.



The Profile data plus an ID photo and the current encrypted password can provide a second layer of confirmation and helps validate that the person associated with a device is the authorized operator and reducing the risk of spoofed devices or unauthorized access to the network. This is just one of the many security features built into the LifeRing system.
